



Dying Matters Leeds Community Grant Steering Group | Terms of Reference

Purpose

To act on behalf of the Leeds Dying Matters Partnership to administer a small grant programme during Dying Matters Week.

Role and responsibilities

- To oversee the grant funding assigned to Dying Matters Leeds Week and ensure it is spent on activities that promote and celebrate Dying Matters
- To encourage voluntary and statutory organisations to organise appropriate events during Dying Matters Leeds Week
- To assist in coordinating, publicising and promoting these events, including branding appropriate events with the Dying Matters Leeds logo
- To ensure the range of events represents the diverse communities of Leeds
- To evaluate events and use this evaluation to inform future Dying Matters Leeds planning

Accountability

The Dying Matters Leeds Community Grant Steering Group is a sub group of Dying Matters Leeds Partnership and reports to that partnership. The Leeds Dying Matters Partnership coordinates a citywide campaign for Leeds to open a dialogue with local communities in Leeds about death and dying and to enable people to plan for the last years of their life; it is accountable to the NHS through the Palliative Care Strategy Group.

Leeds Bereavement Forum will hold the funds and administer the Dying Matters Leeds Community Grants process on behalf of the Leeds Dying Matters Partnership.
